Report on Tree Planation Programme



The 'Tree Planting Program' was held on January 1, 2021 by NSS department Arts and Commerce College, Kasegaon., was in the chair-person. All the teaching, non-teaching staff and students participated enthusiastically and planted trees. Dr. S. R. Mane discussed the importance of the tree planting. He said that tree plantation is important because it provides fresh fruits, vegetables, nuts, and other foods for the survival of life on Earth. They are the producers and the source of food energy for all living things to survive, as they are at the bottom of the food chain. Aside from this basic need, tree plantation is important for humans to meet their medicinal needs, fodder for domestic animals, household tools, fuel, and so on. He added that according to one research, one acre of forest may create up to 4 tons of oxygen while absorbing up to 6 tons of carbon dioxide, enough to feed about 20 people for a year.

The students brought various saplings including Ashoka, Neem, Belpatra, Saptparni, Kadamb and Kachnaar. The students participated in the drive enthusiastically and helped each other in planting the saplings. All the saplings were planted in the school ground by students. The students along with the teachers also took an oath to look after the planted saplings, plant more and more trees and encourage others to do the same. Some of the students also shared their experiences and shared their joy with others.

Prof. Bharat Kharat NSS Coordinator noted how deforestation has slowed down significantly over the past 25 years. The goal of halting deforestation and restoring forests, as set out in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, is an attainable objective if we continue our efforts. Health Check-up Camp

On 16th February 2021, on the occasion of the birthday of Water Resources Minister Namdar Jayant Patil Saheb, NSS Department and Primary Health Center Kasegaon jointly organized a health check-up camp for girls. The health officer Dr. Rhutul Raskar inaugurated the function and reported on the diseases, symptoms and treatment that they cause to girls due to the shortage of various components in the blood. Dr. S. R. Mane, the principal was in the chairperson. In the presidential speech, he called on the girls to participate in the camp and affirmed the importance of health.

More than 100 participants participated in this camp, including girls, teachers and non-teaching staff from the college. Total blood was checked-up in this health camp. In this, blood components like haemoglobin, RBC, platelets and WBC were checked. As per the demand and request by the staff, free calcium, thyroid pills were distributed on behalf of Primary Health Center, Kasegaon. The printed reports of check-up were sent to individuals and advice on taking precautions was given.

For this check-up camp, the team included Dr. Rhutul Raskar, Dr. Rajendra Bhise, and supported by Mayuri Swant, V. D. Jagtap, Tushar Kumatekar, Kavita Pawar, Santosh Kakade, Sarika Chavan and Anjana Bandgar. The function ended successfully under the direction of the principal of the college.


