



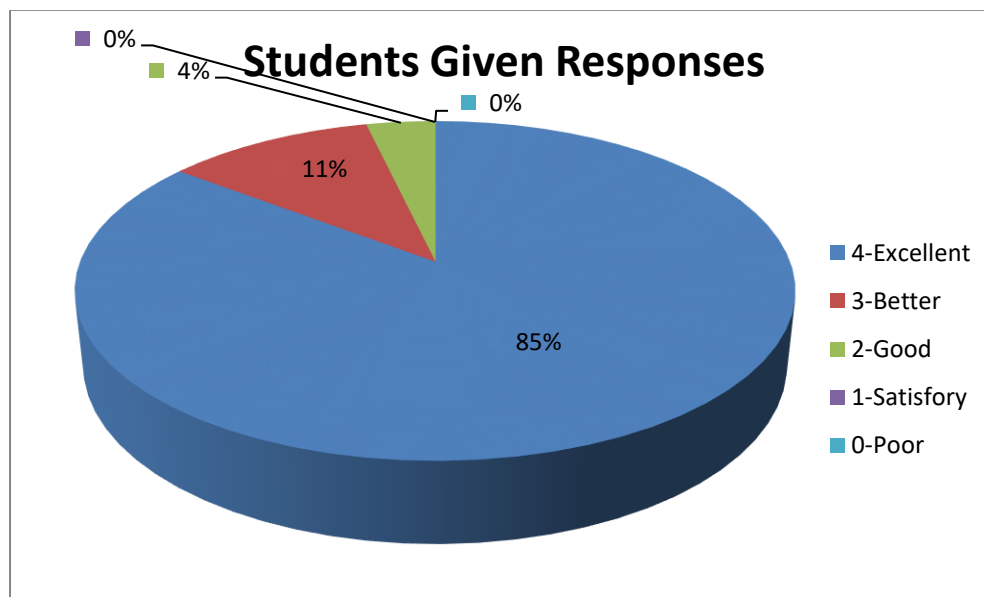
## Student Satisfaction Survey Analysis for Year 2018-19

- 0 – Below 30%

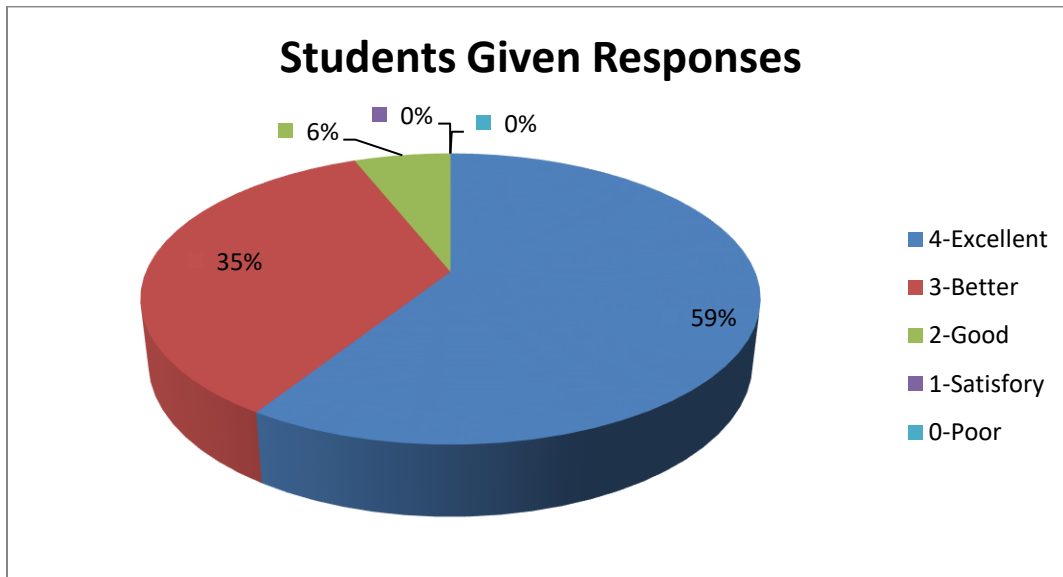

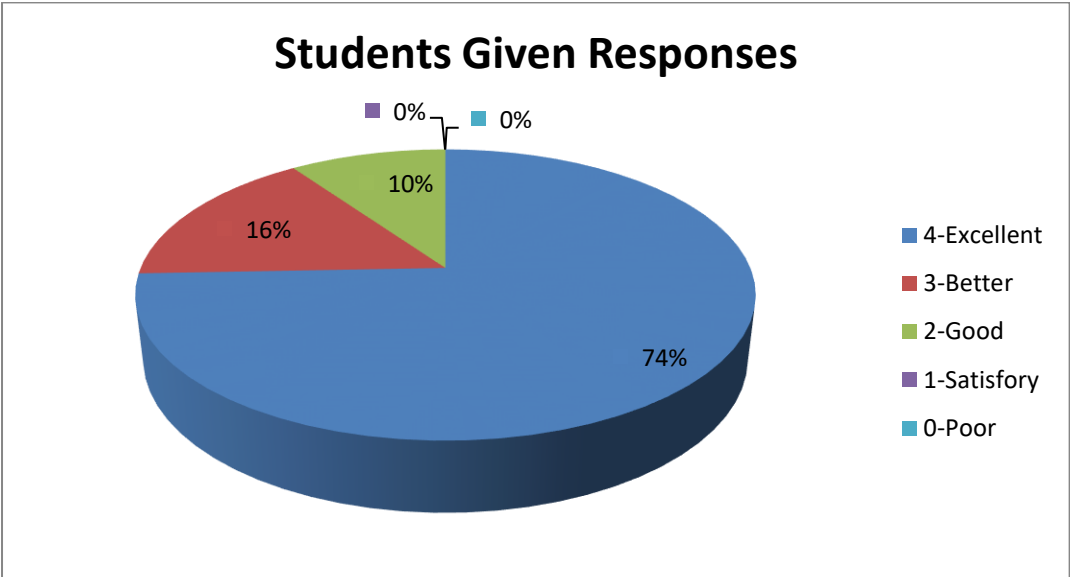

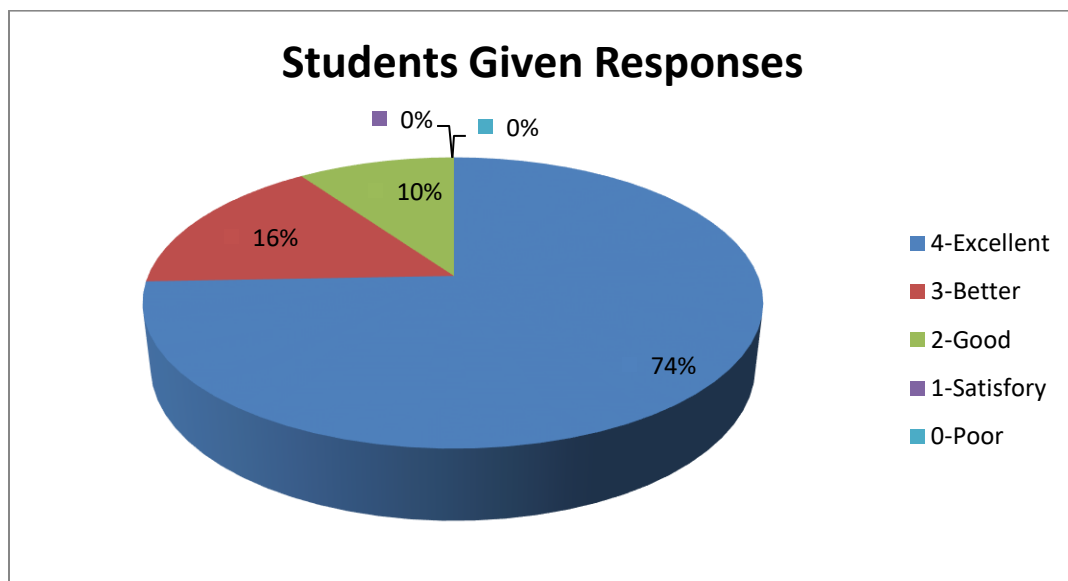

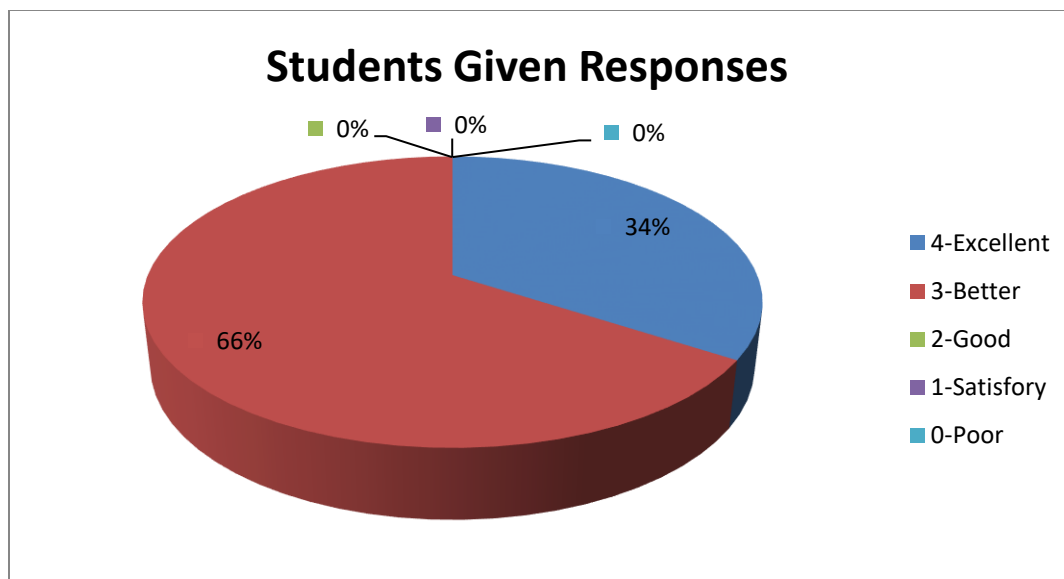

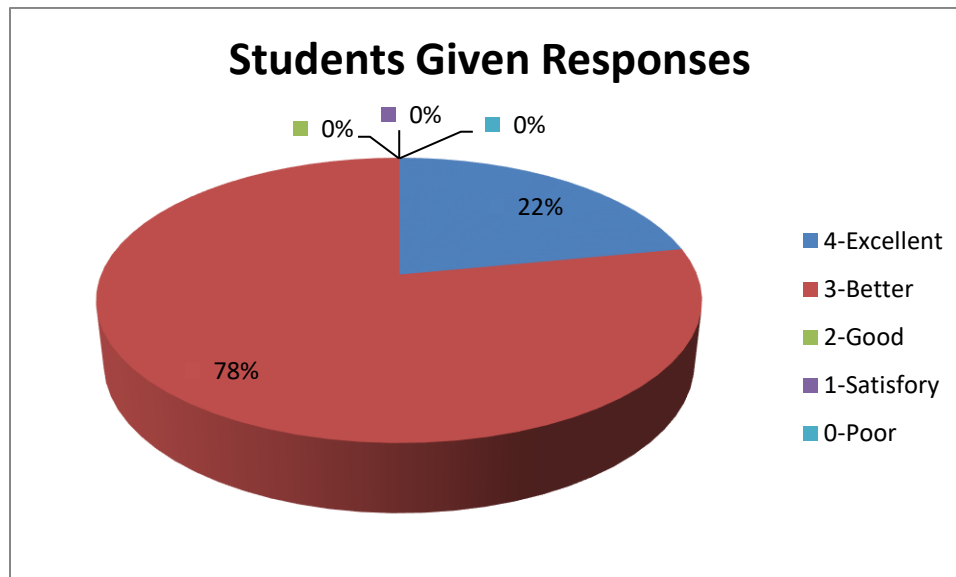

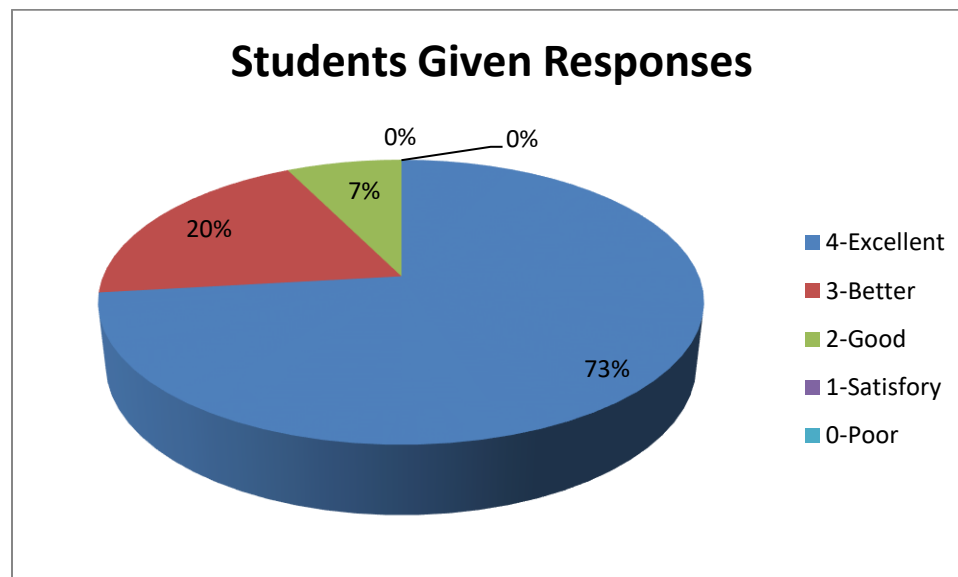

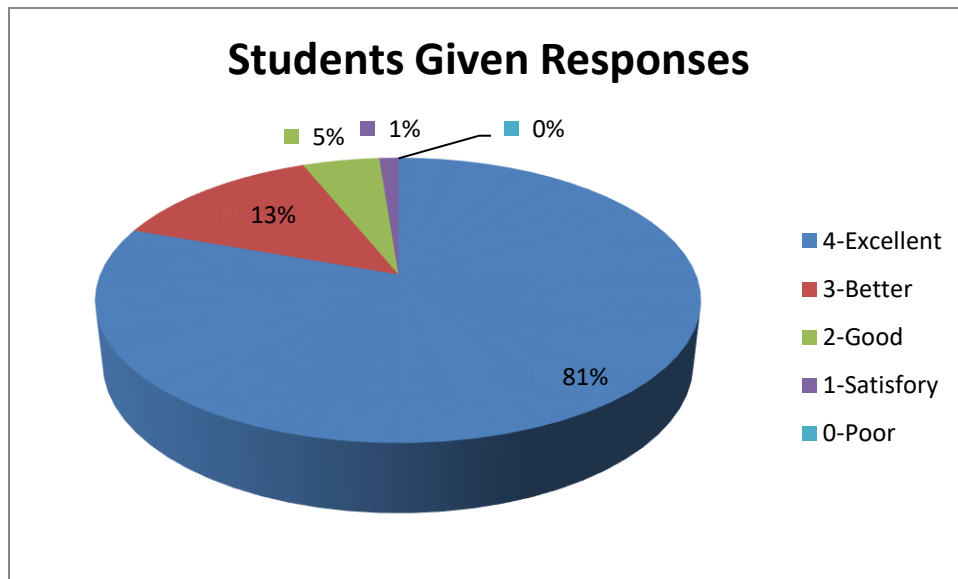

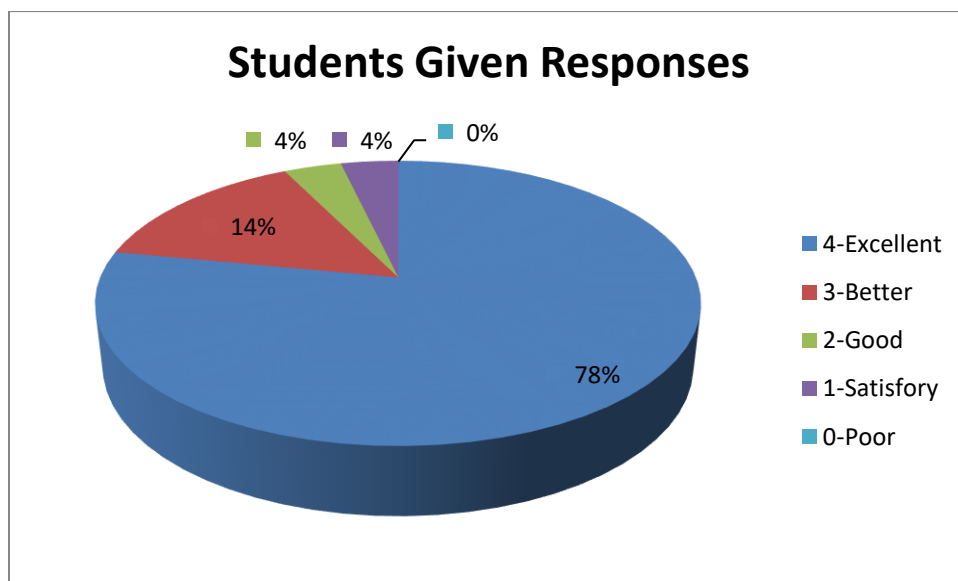

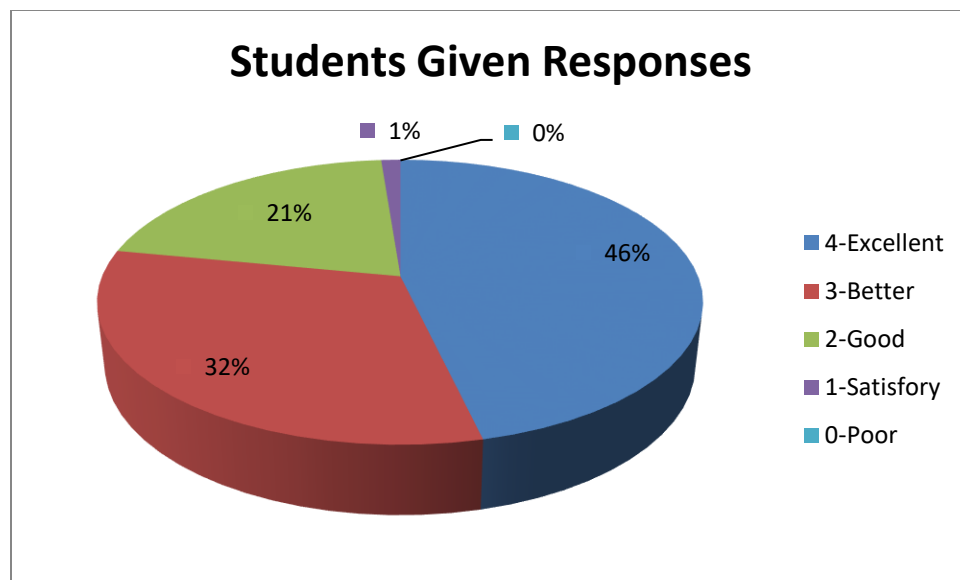

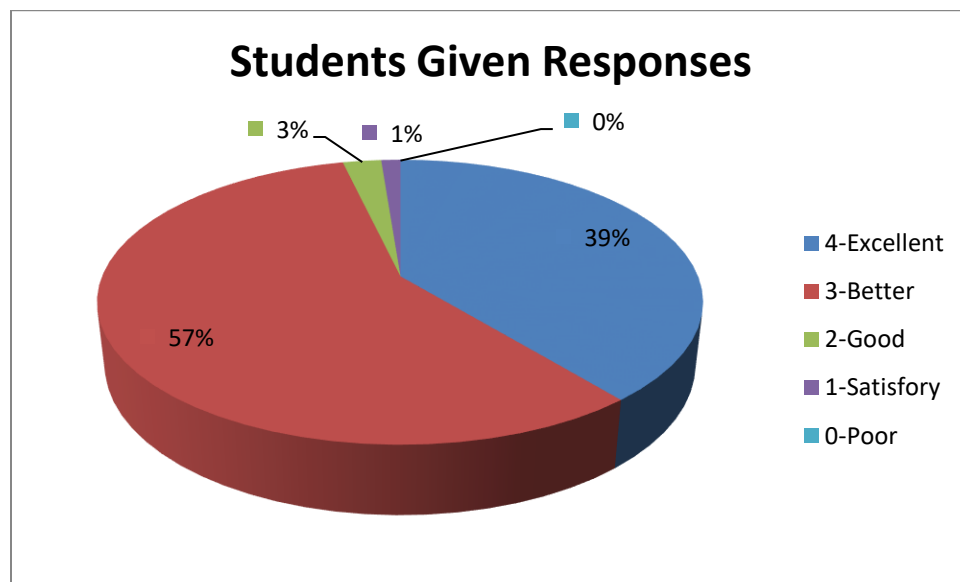

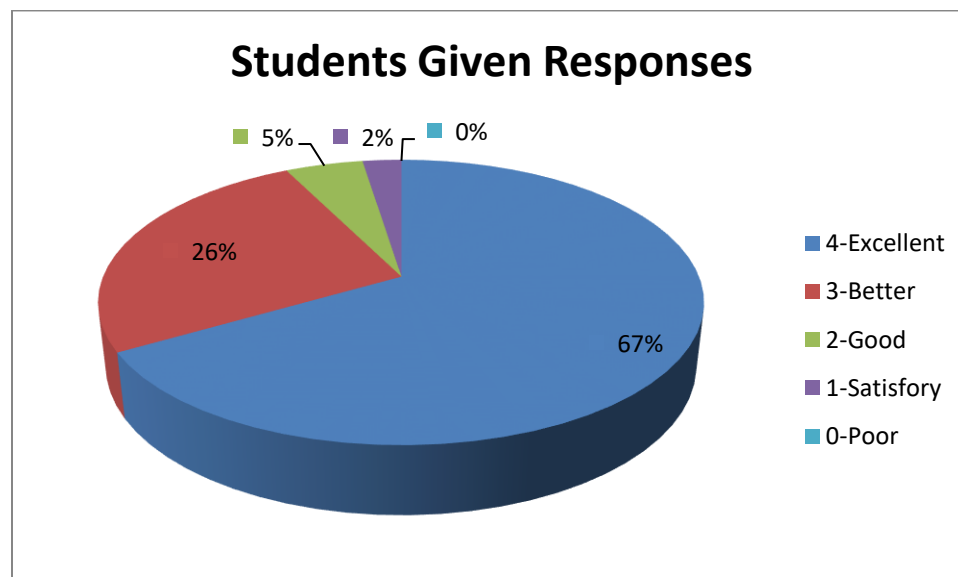
